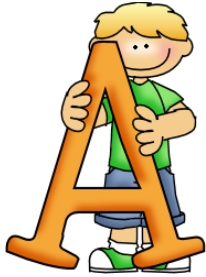

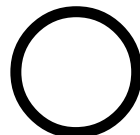
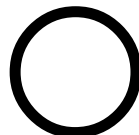
Please give your child lots of encouragement.

Here is an example of a verbal response to guide you:

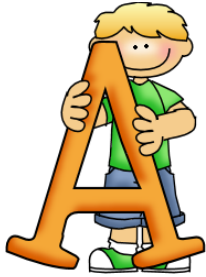
The Ladybird picture does not belong. The rest of the other pictures are green.
