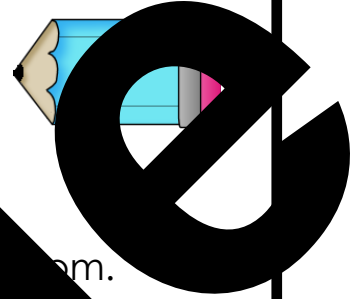


**Exercise 2**

7. Winners will be announced on August 20, 2017. Prizes include \$500 in cash, two tickets to a Coldplay Concert, a possible trip to the festival, and publication in the Hong Kong Daily News.
